The ANWB small campsite inspections

What counts and how does a campsite earn points?

The ANWB inspects the quality of campsites and to provide its members with good information. From 2022 onwards, we will introduce a new classification model that has been specially developed for small campsites (campsites with a maximum of 60 pitches).

In this document we will explain to you what our inspectors look for in a small campsite and how you can earn points as a small campsite.

Stars

The final scores of the ANWB campsite inspections are given in **green** stars on a scale of 0 to 5; half-stars are also possible. The campsite's score remains valid until it is inspected again.

Total of 1000 points

According to the ANWB classification, a campsite can be awarded a total of 1000 points. The spread is as follows:

1.	Sanitary facilities	500 points
2.	Grounds	300 points
3.	Catering facilities	80 points
4.	Recreation	45 points
5.	Swimming	75 points

Points can be awarded for the presence of certain facilities and for their quality. An ANWB inspector evaluates the quality of the facilities on the basis of the following scale: Very good (VG), Good (G), Sufficient (S) or Normal (N) and Insufficient (I) of Simple (SI). An extra scale, More than sufficient (MS), has been added to the quality of sanitary facilities.

1. Sanitary facilities

A campsite can be awarded a maximum of 500 points for the sanitary facilities: 90 points for the presence of special sanitary facilities 410 points for quality

1.1 Special sanitary facilities

A campsite can be awarded the following points for special sanitary facilities:

•	Wash cubicles Yes/No	20/0 points
•	Combi-sanitary facilities Yes/No	20/0 points
•	Private sanitary facilities in sanitary facilities building Yes/No	20/0 points
•	Washing machine Yes/No	10/0 points
•	Clothes dryer Yes/No	5/0 points

•	Baby bathing area Yes/No	15/0 points
•	Toilet for the disabled Yes/No	10/0 points
•	Shower for the disabled Yes/No	5/0 points
•	Washbasin for the disabled Yes/No	5/0 points

NB1: 90 points is the maximum score for special sanitary facilities. But if you add up all the points, you see that a total of 110 points can be awarded for special sanitary facilities. This is based on the viewpoint that a campsite does not need to have all the facilities in order to get the maximum score on this element.

NB2: Campsites with 100% private sanitary facilities at the pitch are given 60 bonus points to compensate for the lack of points for wash cubicles, combi-sanitary facilities and private sanitary facilities in the sanitary facilities building.

1.2 Quality sanitary facilities

The points given for the quality of the sanitary facilities are spread as follows:

NB1: The inspector does not evaluate sanitary facilities buildings that are for the use of permanent guests only. Quality demands are stricter for a sanitary facilities building that is used by many campers at tourist pitches compared to one that is used by fewer camping guests. If there are several sanitary facilities buildings, the weighted average determines the quality of the score.

NB2: 410 points is the maximum score for quality sanitary facilities. But if you add up all the points, you see that a total of 430 points can be awarded for quality sanitary facilities. This is based on the viewpoint that a small campsite that has, for example, a simple sanitary building, but has invested in a heated sanitary building, will receive extra points for this.

2. Grounds

A campsite can be awarded a maximum of 300 points for the grounds: 210 points for the tourist pitches 90 points for the grounds in general

2.1 Tourist pitches:

The points for the tourist pitches are spread as follows:

•	Construction and maintenance pitch

Number pitches with own water supply

Number pitches with own drain

Number pitches with private sanitary facilities

• Size of pitch (Most \geq 150m² /

2.2 Grounds in general:

The points awarded for grounds in general are spread as follows:

•	Impression grounds VG/ G/ S/ I	45/36/18/0 points
•	Grounds hygiene VG/ G/ S/ I	25/20/10/0 points
•	View: Very attractive/Attractive/Neutral	15/10/0 points
•	Quiet at the campsite Yes/No	10/0 points
•	Quietly located Yes/No	10/0 points

NB: 90 points is the maximum score for grounds in general. But if you add up all of the points, you see that a total of 105 points can be awarded for grounds. This is based on the viewpoint that campsites should be able to get the maximum score without being considered to have a (very) attractive view.

3. Catering facilities

A campsite can be awarded a maximum of 100 points for catering facilities: 45 points for groceries and cooking

50 points for eating facilities

3.1 Groceries and cooking

The points awarded for groceries are spread as follows:

•	Bread available at campsite* Yes/No	10/0 points
•	Kiosk (basic groceries)* Yes/No	15/0 points
•	Shop/Supermarket (within 100m)*	20/0 points

NB: Only the highest score of the above 3 facilities counts.

Sale of regional/farm products Yes/No	5/0 points
BBQ for communal use Yes/No	5/0 points
Microwave Yes/No	5/0 points
Fridge Yes/No	5/0 points
Cooking facility Yes/No	5/0 points
	BBQ for communal use Yes/No Microwave Yes/No Fridge Yes/No

NB: 45 points is the maximum score for groceries and cooking. But if you add up all of the points, you see that a total of 50 points can be awarded for grounds. This is based on the viewpoint that campsites should be able to get the maximum score without selling regional/farm products.

3.2 Eating facilities

Campsites can get points for the presence of a restaurant or snack bar/take-away meals within 100 metres.

The points awarded for eating facilities are spread as follows:

Snack bar and/or Take-away meals (within 100 m) Yes/No
 Restaurant (within 100 m) Yes/No
 10/0 points

• Evaluation Restaurant

Very good/ Good/ Normal/ Simple 15/12/8/4 points

NB: A restaurant is evaluated only if it is located on the campsite or just outside of the campsite so that the campsite influences the quality of the restaurant.

4. Recreation

A campsite can be awarded a maximum of 125 points for recreation:

15 points for outdoor playground

30 points for sports and recreation

4.1 Outdoor playground

The points awarded for outdoor playground(s) are spread as follows:

Outdoor playground Yes/No
 5/0 points

• Surface area playground(s)

(total surface area playground divided by number of pitches)

From 4m2/ 2-4m2/ 1-2m2/ 0-1m2 5/4/2/0 points

• Total impression playground(s) VG/ G/ S/ I 5/4/2/0 points

4.2 Sports and recreation

The points awarded for sports and recreation are spread as follows:

•	Sports facilities (3 or more/ 2/ 1/ none)	5/4/2/0 points
•	Special recreation facility Yes/No	5/0 points
•	Bike rental Yes/No	5/0 points
•	Covered bicycle parking Yes/No	5/0 points
•	Bad weather facility Yes/No	5/0 points
•	Total impression sports facilities VG/ G/ S/ I	5/4/2/0 points

5. Swimming

A campsite can be awarded a maximum of 75 points for swimming in a swimming pool or natural water; one part can compensate for the other:

A campsite with only one or more swimming pools can be awarded the maximum of 75 points. A campsite with only the possibility to swim in natural water can be awarded a maximum of 55 points.

5.1 Swimming pools

Campsites can be awarded points for the presence of a swimming pool within 100 metres of the campsite.

The ANWB divides swimming pools into three types:

•	Outdoor swimming pool (within 100 m) Yes/No	20/0 points
•	Swimming pool with sliding roof (within 100 m) Yes/No	25/0 points
•	Indoor swimming pool (within 100 m) Yes/No	30/0 points

NB: Only the highest score of the above three facilities counts.

A campsite can also be given points for the presence of a:

• Toddler's pool(s) (within 100 m) Yes/No 10/0 points

A campsite can also be given points for the features below only if the swimming pool/toddler's pool is located on the campsite or just outside of the campsite so that the campsite influences the quality:

Construction swimming pool/toddler's pool

Very good/ Good/ Normal/ Simple 10/8/4/0 points*

Maintenance and hygiene swimming pool

VG/ G/ S/ I 15/12/6/0 points*

• Surface area swimming pool(s)

(total surface area of water divided by number of pitches)

Starting at 2 m²/ 1,5-2 m²/ 1-1,5 m²/ 0,5-1 m²/ 0-0,5 m² 20/15/10/5/0 points**

• Toddler's area integrated into swimming pool Yes/No 5/0 points

NB: A campsite is given points for an integrated toddler's area only if there is no separate toddler's pool.

- * If there are diverse types of swimming pools, the average score for construction, maintenance and hygiene counts.
- ** The surface area of swimming pools is based on all of the water surfaces of all pools (indoor, outdoor and with a sliding roof)

NB: A campsite with 75 points is given the maximum score. But if you add up all the points, you see that a swimming pool with a roof is given 80 points and an indoor swimming pool 85 points. This is based on the viewpoint that a campsite in a warm country should be able to get a maximum score if it has only an outdoor swimming pool.

5.2 Swimming in natural water

Campsites can be given points for the presence of a beach at the ocean and/or a lake within 500 m and for a beach along a river within 100 m.

The points awarded for a beach at the sea and/or lake are spread as follows:

Distance to beach at sea/lake 50 m or less Yes/No
 Distance to beach at sea/lake starting at 50 to 150 m Yes/No
 Distance to beach at sea/lake starting at 150 to 500 m Yes/No
 5/0 points*

The points awarded for a beach along a river are spread as follows:

Distance to beach along a river 50 m or less Yes/No
 Distance to beach along a river starting at 50 to 100 m Yes/No
 5/0 points*

A campsite can be given points for the following features only if the distance to the beach is 150 m or less (NB: for a river, 100 m or less):

Impression beach Very good/ Good/ Normal/ Simple
 20/13/6/0 points**

Surface area beach

Royal (starting at 10.000 m²)/ Normal (1.000-10.000 m²)/

Small (100-1.000 m²)/ Very small (less than 100 m²) 20/13/6/0 points**

For the classification:

- * The distance with the highest score counts.
- ** If a campsite has more than one beach, the beach with the highest score for impression counts. This also applies to the surface of the beach.

NB: If there is an obstacle (road, railway) between the campsite and the beach, 5 points are subtracted.
